## DUTIES OF SHIPS' DELEGATES

- It shall be the duty of the Agents and Patrolmen, in their respective Branches or Districts, to appoint from among the members of the crew of each outgoing vessel one member to act as a Ship's Delegate.
  It shall be the duty of the Ship's Delegate to take the name, number and financial standing of each member of the crew and note same on the report blank provided for the purpose.
- 3. The Ship's Delegate shall keep an account of the overtime worked by the crew, noting the time of turning to and knocking off, and shall compare time with the officer in charge after knocking off.
- 4. He shall assist the Agents and Patrolmen in the performance of their duties, specifically by informing the latter of any vacancy occurring, or likely to occur, in the crew.
- 5. He shall keep in mind and advise the crew that any difference of opinion about the rules of the law is no reason for quitting the vessel; that, in fact, such action solves the dispute in favor of the vessel, and that such matters can be attended to when the vessel arrives at headquarters or any of the Branches.
