<b>Original Tankerman Assistant</b>	13.401	
An approved tankerman course for the cargo sought within the previous 5 years; <b>OR</b> 90 days deck service on tank ship or self-propelled tank vessels certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate <b>and</b> successful completion of a USCG exam.		
<b>If holding Tankerman Assistant (DL or LG) and wanting to add the other cargo:</b> An approved tankerman course for the cargo sought completed within the previous 5 years; <b>OR</b> 45 days deck service on tank ship or self-propelled tank vessels certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate <b>and</b> successful completion of a USCG exam		
<b>Original Tankerman Engineer</b>	13.501	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 90 days service as an engineering officer in the engine department on tank ship or self-propelled tank vessel certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate; <b>OR</b></li> <li>• 90 days rating or cadet service in the engine department on tank ship or self-propelled tank vessel certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate; <b>OR</b></li> <li>• Combination of service listed above (Total must be at least 90 days). <b>AND</b></li> <li>• Cargo course completed within the previous 5 years, DL or LG appropriate.</li> </ul>		
<b>If holding Tankerman Engineer (DL or LG) and wanting to add the other cargo:</b> 45 days total service as listed above in any combination.
